













**ID**: Cap yellow-orange; flat (somewhat depressed in age). Blunt gill-like ridges. Use KOH.

**Habitat**: Solitary, scattered, groups. On leaf litter and wood in hardwood forests.

**Cap**: 0.4 - 2" [1 - 5 cm]

Cinnamon-/dark-/reddish-brown (pinkish-tan in age). Dry. Nearly smooth. Convex/flat/shallowly depressed. Margin thin, inrolled when young, wavy in age (sometimes contorted or splitting radially). Flesh whish/brownish, thin, tough.

Gills: Whitish (pinkish-buff inb age). Attached (nearly free in age).

Spores: Creamy-white. Teardrop-shaped, smooth, hyaline.

**Stalk**: 0.8 – 2.8" X 1/8" [2 – 7 cm X 3 mm]

Buff; darkening to brownish/reddish-brown/nearly black near base. Dry, tough. Smooth at apex, finely hairy/velvety at base. Equal or apex flares.

Frequency: Very common.

**Locations**: BIGBR, DANPV, FRANF, GATWY, GONRA, HIRIP, LONGC, MANWD, MPENA, OTHER, PATRP, PIGTL, RKBRP, ROBNC, ROGOR, SLMLP, SYRIV, WINTR, WSTRP.

**Notes**: Mycobank 213714. Franciscan Friars specimen verified by microscopic examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH olive on cap.
