ID: Yellow/orange/buff “match-stick” head on pale stalk in shallow water in woods/bogs.

Habitat: Scattered, groups, in shallow water on decaying leaves/needles/twigs/debris in woodlands/ bogs.

Fruiting body: 1 – 2” [2 – 5 cm], head and stalk
 Translucent yellow/orange/buff (dull orange in age), somewhat gelatinous, smooth/slightly wrinkled, shiny, spindle/pear-shaped or elliptic/lobed.

Stalk: 0.8 – 1.5” x 1/16 – 1/8” [2 – 4 cm x 1.5 – 3 mm]
 Whitish/pale translucent gray (sometimes pink), smooth/shiny, may taper up.

Ascospores: Sausage-shaped, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: CASFD, HIRIP, PIGTL.

Notes: Mycobank 317769. All locations were in shallow, barely moving sections of streams/seeps. High Ridge Park specimen identified by iNaturalist.
