Common Morel Yellow Morel Morchella americana Morchellaceae

J F M A M J J A S O N D -++ +++

**ID**: Body color variable; cylindrical w/ pits and ridges. Stalk whitish; granular, sometimes ribbed.

**Habitat**: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in variety of habitats, usually under trees, frequently tulip trees (*Liriodendron tulipifera*).

**Fruiting Body**: 0.8 - 7" H x 0.8 - 2.8" W [2 - 17.5 cm x 2 - 7 cm] Yellow/yellow-brown (grayish when immature). Ovoid/conic/somewhat cylindric, sponge-like. Pits round/elongated/irregular. Hollow.

**Stalk**: 1 – 4.5" x 0.8 – 2.8" [2.5 – 11.5 cm x 2 – 7 cm] Whitish, equal or enlarged downward, granular, often ribbed, hollow.

Spores: Cream/light yellow.

Frequency: Common.

**Locations**: FULSA, GUIFP, HENPV, KALIL, MCLUR, MPENA, MTPLT, NOFPK, SAVMT, WATFD, WILLK, WINTR.

**Notes**: Mycobank 563915. There was a major revision to this genus in 2015 which concluded that *M. esculenta* does not occur in North America. The specimens photographed here appear to be *M. americana*.
