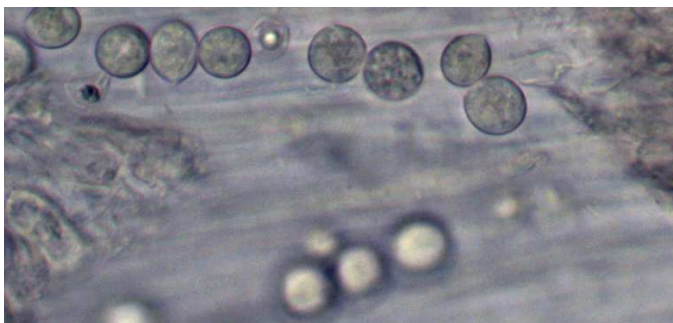

ID: Pinkish-purplish (grayish-brown in age); convex, pleated.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On bark of standing deciduous/coniferous trees. Moss often present.

Cap: 1/8 – 3/8" [3 - 10 mm]

Pinkish-purplish/reddish-brown (pale grayish-brown in age). Convex. Pleated. Tiny pale granules. Shrivels in dry conditions (reviving in wet).

Gills: Pale grayish/whitish, similar to cap. Distant. Bluntly attached, often w/ collar. Secondary gills.

Stalk: 3/16 – 3/8" [5 – 10 mm]

Color or cap. Base w/ only a few white hairs; inserted into bark.

Spores: *White*. Nearly round, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: DANPV, MTPLT, MURHL.

Notes: Mycobank 499413. Mount Pleasant specimen identified by G. Lincoff (*pers.comm.*) Gorman Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
