**ID**: Yellowish (grayish-pink in age), stalk yellow (but fades); hairs at base. Conifers.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. In coniferous or hardwood forests.

**Cap**: 3/8 - 3/4" [1 – 2 cm]

Dark yellowish, sometimes tinged grayish-green (white/grayish-pink in age). Egg-shaped (convex w/ umbo in age). Often slimy/sticky. Pileus peels easily. Margin becomes grooved. Flesh yellowish, thin. Unpleasant odor.

Gills: Yellowish/white/buff. Attached. Subdistant. Narrow.

**Spores**: White/pale buff. Tear-drop shaped , smooth.

**Stalk**: 2 - 3" x 1/32 - 1/16" [5 - 7.5 cm x 0.75 - 1.5 mm]


Bright yellow (fades in age). Cylindrical. Hollow. Coarse hairs at base. Slightly sticky.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ANNRK, RKBRP.
