**ID**: Cap dirty tan; bell-shaped w/ broad umbo; radially lined. Gill edges serrated in age. Stalk grayish-whiteabove, dark below..

Habitat: Solitary, groups. On decaying hardwood stumps/logs.

**Cap**: 1 - 3" [2.5 - 7.5 cm]

Brownish (dirty tan/cinnamon-brown in age). Bell-shaped w/ broad umbo. Margin w/ veil remnants, inrolled (spreading in age), wrinkled to radially lined. Flesh thin (1 mm).

**Gills**: Whitish/grayish/pink-tinged; edges serrated in age. Attached. Close/almost distant. Moderately broad, crossveins in age. Depth 3 mm.

Spores: White. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

**Stalk**: 2 – 5" x 1/16 – 1/4" [5 – 12.5 cm x 1.5 – 5 mm] Grayish-white above, darker gray/brown below. Smooth/light appressed hairs. Equal or twisted. Mycelium white. Hollow. Brittle.

Frequency: Common.

**Locations**: CASCT, FRANF, GONRA, HAMVL, LONGC, MANWD, MCHPV, MPENA, PIGTL, ROBNC, RKBRP, SAVPK, UMDCF, WFRDP, WSTRP.
