ID: Clusters, often on downed limbs. Cap reddish-orange, paler in age; hemispheric/convex; grooved; viscid. Stalk base densely hairy. May stain hands orange.

Habitat: Clusters. On stumps/downed limbs/ground in hardwood forests.

Cap: 0.4 – 2" [1 – 5 cm]

Reddish-orange (yellowish-orange/pale in age). Viscid/slightly glutinous. Convex/hemispheric/broadly convex (may be slightly depressed in age), grooved. When young, margin typically translucent, grooved and moist. Flesh white/ orangish, thick.

Gills: Pinkish-orange/orange; stain yellowish-orange, edges brilliant reddish-orange/orangish-red. Notched. Close, forked. Secondary gills.

Spores: *White*. Ellipsoid, smooth.

Stalk: 1 – 3" x 1/16 – 1/8" [2.5 – 7.5 cm x 1.5 – 4 mm]

Orange overall, sometimes yellow near top. Powdery (smooth/glutinous in age). Sometimes slightly enlarged top. Base densely hairy (typically orangish). Hollow; pliable.

Frequency: Common.

Locations: CASCT, GONRA, GWACP, MCHPV, MPENA, MTPLT, MURHL, RKBRP, SAVPK, SUKBR, WESRP, WINTR, WSKPV.

Notes: Mycobank 122737. Savage Park (8/27/2008) specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. Stains hands orange.
