ID: Cap gray-brown; conical/bell-shaped. Alkaline odor (or not).

Habitat: Dense clusters. On conifer stumps or logs.

Cap: 0.2 – 1.2" [5 – 30 mm]

Gray-brown/brown. Conical, expanding to bell-shaped. Margin slightly striate. Flesh whitish, thin. Strong alkaline odor (or not).

Gills: Whitish. Attached. Close/distant.

Spores: *White*. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 2.4 – 3.9" x 1/16 – 1/8" [6 – 10 cm x 1 – 3 mm]

Brown/gray-brown. Pliable.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BOLPL, GONRA, RKBPR, WINTR.
