Bone Polypore

ID: White spoon-shaped cups; small pores; off-center stalk.

Habitat: Dead conifers or dead birch.

Fruiting Body: Up to $4.7 \times 5.2^{\circ} \times 0.8^{\circ}$ thick [12cm x 13 cm x 2 cm] White/grayish/buff. Smooth. Several circular/spoon-shaped caps. Convex (slightly depressed in age). Flesh white (3 – 10 mm; very hard when dry).

Pores: White/yellowish; angular (3 - 5/mm). Tubes slightly decurrent (1 - 3 mm).

Stalk: 1 - 3.5" x up to 1.75" [1 - 3 cm x 3 - 10 mm]. White/cream. "sually off-ce"ter or fused.

Spores: White.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: DANPV, FRANF, OTHER, PATRP, PIGTL, ROBNC, SLMLP, SYRIV, TRIRS.

Notes: Photos are all of small and immature specimens.
