ID: Yellowish-brown w/ pink tints on inner surface. Split on side.

Habitat: Solitary, groups. On ground in hardwoods or mixed forests.

Fruiting Body: 0.4 – 1.6" diameter X 0.4 – 0.8" high [1 – 4 x 1 – 2 cm]
Cup-shaped w/ inrolled margin split to base on one side.

Fertile surface pale tan w/ pinkish/peachy tones.

Outer surface brown/reddish-brown, scurfy.

Stalk: Up to 0.4" [\leq 1 cm]
Short, whitish-yellow.

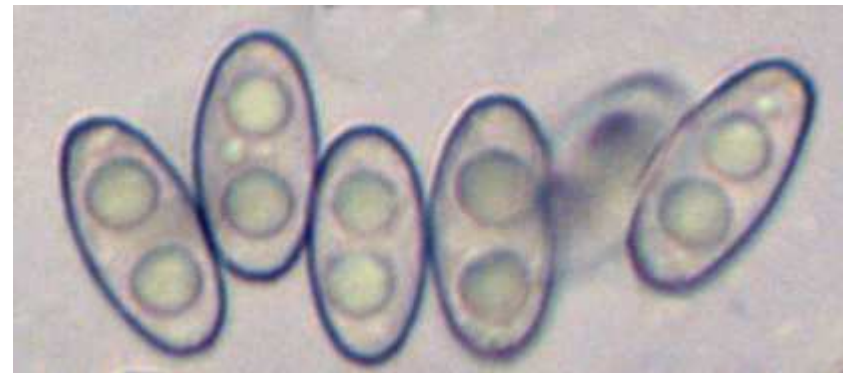
Ascospores: Oval, 2 oil drops.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: LONGC, RKBRP.

Notes: Mycobank 128902. Rockburn Branch Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem; Long Corner by macrocharacteristics only.
