None Perichaena spp
Trichiaceae

J F M A M J J A S O N D

ID: Peridium mustard-yellow and cottony. Sporangia reddish.

Habitat: Dense clusters. On decayed bark, leaves, etc. (depending on species..

Fruiting Body: 1/32 - 1/8" [1 – 3 mm]

Sporangia reddish, smooth. Outer wall disappears, peridium expands to form cottony head.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HTWMA.

Notes: Identification based on macro characteristics, not examination of

spores by microscope.
