ID: Bright orange-yellow toothed sheet w/ long rhizomorphs.

Habitat: Sheet-like and flattened against underside of hardwood logs.

Fruiting Body: 0.8 – 2.4" [2 – 6 cm] sheet
Bright orange-yellow, toothed surface w/ branching rhizomorphs
(3.9 – 7.9" [10 – 20 cm] long).

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: MPENA, PIGTL, WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 535297.

Synonyms: *Hydnophlebia chrysorhiza*. *Hydnum chryscomum*. *Mycoacia fragilissima*. *Oxydontia fragilissima*.
