ID: Yellowish-cinnamon cap, membranous ring (unless old).

Habitat: Groups, clusters. On well-decayed deciduous wood/sawdust.

Cap: 0.8 – 2.3 " [2 – 6 cm].

Pale to yellowish-cinnamon (fades fron center outward to pale yellowishtan in age). Smooth (but moist/sticky/slippery). Margin striate in age. Flesh like cap. Hygrophorous.

Gills: Pinkish-tan (cinnamon in age). Covered w/ partial veil at first.

Spores: Brown. Ellipsoid, w/ or w/o apical pore, smooth, brownish.

Stalk: 1.5 - 3.5" x 1/8 - 1.2" [4 - 9 cm x 4 - 12 mm] Paler than cap. Dry. Scurfy in middle part. Upward-flaring, membranous ring near top (or only zone in age).


Frequency: Uncommon.
