ID: Cap white w/ fibrils, margin inrolled. Stalk off-center; often tapered down.

Habitat: Solitary/clustered. Dead conifer wood.

Cap: 1.4 – 4" [3.5 – 10 cm]
 White. Smooth. Fan-/shell-shaped. Flesh white, very thin.

Gills: White. Crowded. Narrow. Decurrent.

Spores: White.

Stalk: White; plug-like, absent..

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: TRIRS.
