ID: Yellow/yellow-brown. Bell-shaped/flat. Gills yellowish/brownish-pink.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. Decaying hardwoods.

Cap: 3/8 - 1.1" [1 - 3 cm]

Yellow Pluteus

Bright yellow (hygrophanous, fades to yellow-brown in age). Moist when fresh. Wrinkled or nearly smooth. Broadly convex/ bell-shaped w/ low umbo (flat in age). Margin translucent/striate. Flesh white/yellowish.

Gills: Whitish, then yellowish (brownish-pink in age). Free. Close.

Spores: *Brownish-pink*. Nearly round, smooth, tan.

Stalk: 1-2.4" x 1/16-1/8" [2.5-6 cm x 1.5-3 mm] Yellow (darker in age). Moist. Smooth. Nearly equal. White basal mycelium.


Frequency: Fairly common.
