ID: Cap reddish-/rusty-brown (fades in age); radially wrinkled; broadly convex (nearly flat in age). Stalk whitish w/ silky fibrils; white mycelium at base.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. On decaying hardwoods, mulch, or debris.

Cap: 1.1 - 4" [3 - 10 cm]

Dark reddish-/rusty-brown (dull orange-brown/dingy tan in age). Young f.b. covered w/ silky white fibrils. Radially grooved/wrinkled. Convex/broadly convex (nearly flat in age), sometimes w/ broad umbo. Margin sometimes w/ veil remnants. Flesh pale-brown.

Gills: Dull-white/pale brown (purplish-/rusty-brown w/ edges minutely fringed in age). Free/attached high. Some w/ white edges.

Spores: *Purple-brown/black*. Ellipsoid, smooth w/ apical pore, dark brown.


Stalk: 1.5 - 4" x 3/8 - 5/8" [4 - 10 cm x 1 - 1.6 cm] White/silky pruinose near apex; whitish/pale brown below; coated w/ silky fibrils (darker in age). Conspicuous white mycelium.

Frequency: Common.

Locations: BIGBR, CEDLP, FARMS, FOXCH, FRANF, GONRA, MCHPV, MPENA, MURHL, PIGTL, ROGOR, SLMLP, UMDCF, WSTRP.
