ID: Orange, powdery pustules and black structures on leaves of Star of Bethlehem.

Habitat: On leaves of Star of Bethlehem (*Ornithogalum umbellatum*).

Fruiting Body: Orange, powdery pustules and black structures.

Teleospores: Irregularly ellipsoid, 2-celled, minute warts, brownish walls.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GONRA, GWACP, OTHER, WSTRP.
