

ID: Reddish-brown, cushion-shaped; base usually surrounded by white margin.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered (but separated). On decayed logs.

Fruiting Body: 1/4 - 2.4" X 0.4" thick [0.5 - 6 cm X 1 cm] Reddish-brown; hemispheric/cushon-shaped. Smoth/wrinkled cortex. Base surrounded by white margin.

Spores: Dark brown. Round, reticulated, reddish-brown.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: DANPV, FRANF, HENPV, MURHL, PATBT.

Synonym: Enteridium splendens.
