ID: Cap red to purplish-red; convex (flat/ shallowly depressed in age). Stalk white; yellowish-orange below. Use KOH.

Habitat: Groups. On ground associated w/ pines.

Cap: 1.2 – 3.1" [3 – 8 cm]

Crimson to purple-red. Convex (broadly convex/flat in age with depressed center). Slightly sticky when wet. Margin somewhat striate in age. Cap skin peels halfway to center. Flesh white.

Gills: Pale yellow. Attached. Close.

Spores: Ochre. Nearly round, warted.

Stalk: 1.2 – 2" x 0.4 – 0.8" [3 – 5 cm x 1 – 2 cm]

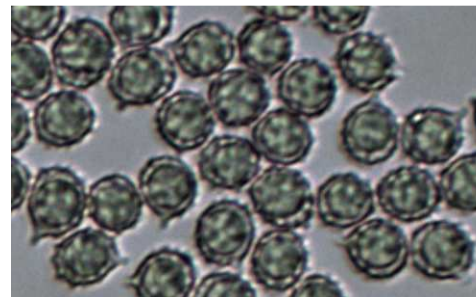
White. Dry. Smooth. Slightly swollen at base.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: SLMLP.

Notes: Mycobank 305359. Schooley Mill Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH yellow on cap.
