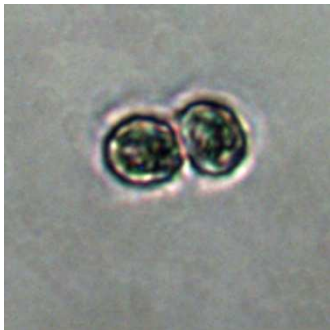

ID: Cap yellow (disc brighter); convex (depressed in age); velvety. Stalk more yellow at base; velvety. Use KOH & FeSO₄.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered. On ground in deciduous or mixed forests.

Cap: 0.8 – 3.2" [2 – 8 cm]

Bright yellow; disc darker/brighter. Velvety. Convex (plane/depressed in age). Margin even (striate in age). Flesh white. Taste mild. No strong odor.

Gills: *White* (pale yellow/clay-colored in age). Attached, often forked near stalk. Crowded. Bruise brown.

Spores: *Creamy yellow*. Nearly round, weak reticulations.

Stalk: 1 – 3.2" x 0.4 – 0.8" [2.5 – 8 cm x 1 – 2 cm]

Like cap or paler; more yellow at base. Dry. Velvety. Equal. Solid/stuffed (hollow in age).

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GONRA.

Notes: Mycobank 187446. Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH turns cap pale magenta. FeSO₄ turns stem salmon.
