ID: Cap color variable. Gills cream-buff.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered. Wet (boggy) areas in mixed forests.

Cap: 1.2 – 2.4" [3 – 6 cm]

Variable (lilac-rose/salmon/greenish-gray/buff). Viscid (wet). Flat (depressed in age). Skin peels. Flesh white, soft.

Gills: Cream-buff. Close.

Spores: Yellow/pale ochre.

Stalk: 1.2 – 2" x 0.2 – 0.8" [3 – 5 cm x 5 – 20 mm]

White (rarely tinted pink). Smooth.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GUIPK.
