

ID: Purplish (or other colors); dry; stalk white w/ pink flush. Use KOH.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered. In hardwood (oak) forests.

Cap: 0.8 – 2.8" [2 – 7 cm]

Purple/purple-red/pinkish, may have olive/yellow/brown tones. Convex (flat or w/ slight depression in age). Dry; whitish bloom when young. Margin grooved in age. Skin peels. Flesh white. Taste mild/oily.

Gills: White (cream/yellowish in age). Close. Often forked.

Spores: *Cream/pale yellow*. Nearly round; irregular crests & ridges, flattened spines, conical warts; prominences 1.2 µm.


Stalk: 0.8-2.4" x 0.2-0.8" [2 -6 cm x 5-20 mm] White, usually flushed pink/purplish. Dry. Smooth.

Frequency: Fairly common..

Locations: BIGBR, BRNBR, DANPV, GONRA, HIRIP, MCHPV, SLMLP.

Notes: Mycobank 214508. Gorman Stream Valley NRA, Daniels, PVSP, High Ridge Park, Schooley Mill Park specimens verified by examination of spores by R. Solem. KOH turns cap orange.
