

ID: Cap straw yellow. Stalk white. Use FeSO₄.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in hardwood forests (especially beech, birch, oak).

Cap: 1.5 - 4" [4 - 10 cm]

Straw yellow/ochraceous. Convex (flattened/depressed in center in age). Finely velvety, dry, nearly smooth. Flesh firm, white/grayish. Faint odor. Cap skin peels very short amount.

Gills: White/pale buff, sometimes w/ brownish stains. Attached. Close. Brittle. Some forking near stalk.

Spores: White/pale cream.

Stalk: 1.5 - 3.5" x 1 - 1.4" [4 - 9 cm x 2.5 - 3.5 cm]

White; sometimes pale yellowish at base. Smooth/somewhat wrinkled.

More or less equal.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GATWY.

Notes: Mycobank 211524. KOH on cap negative. FeSO₄ on stalk negative or slowly stains pink. Gateway specimen cap 3.5"; stalk slowly stained pink.
