ID: Cap white/creamy; gills and stalk white.

Habitat: Solitary, groups. On ground in mixed forests (oak).

Cap: 2 – 4.8" [5 — 12 cm]

Pure white/creamy yellow disc. Dry/slightly viscid. Smooth. Convex (flattened/ depressed in age). Margin even. Flesh white, soft. Taste bitter, then very hot.

Gills: White. Attached/subdecurrent. Close.

Spores: *White*.

Stalk: 1.2 – 2.8" x 0.4 – 0.8" [3 – 7 cm x 1 – 2 cm]

White. Smooth. Equal/tapers up. Random striations. Base brownish.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: PIGTL.
