Habitat: Solitary, groups, overlapping clusters. Decaying hardwoods (oak).

Cap: 2 x 2 x 1/4" thick [5 x 5 x 0.5 cm]

White/ocraceous, finely hairy (soon smooth), thin radial ridges

Fertile surface: Spines poroid w/ eroded pore edges (flattened teeth in

age). Often decurrent

Spores: White.

None

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ROBNC.
