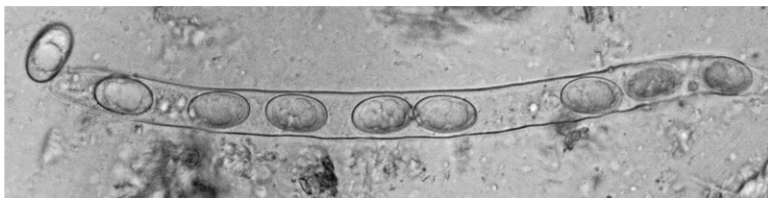

ID: Body tiny, orange-red, smooth; cup-/pill-shaped; margin covered w/ long, dark hairs.

Habitat: Dense groups (usually). On decayed hardwood.

Fruiting Body: 1/16 – 1/10" [1– 1.5 mm]
Cup-/pill-shaped. No stem. Flesh thin and insubstantial.
Fertile surface (top/inner surface) dull orange-red.
Sterile surface (under/outer surface) same; margin w/ long, eyelash-like, dark hairs.

Spores: White. Ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline Ellipsoid/oval, smooth, hyaline (18.8) 19.7-22.0 x 11.1-13.3 (14.2).

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: GONRA, MPENA.

Notes: Mycobank 357342. Murray Hill Gorman Stream Valley specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
