**ID:** Body white, rubbery-gelatinous, enveloping living plant parts.

**Habitat:** Solitary, groups. Enveloping living plant parts/twigs/debris during/after prolonged wet periods.

**Fruiting Body:** Variable, often 2 x 3" [5 – 7.5 cm]  
White, rubbery-gelatinous; forming on soil surface.

**Spores:** *White*. Elliptic/ovoid, flattened/slightly depressed on one side, smooth, hyaline..

**Frequency:** Fairly common.

**Locations:** CEDLP, DANPV, FRANF, HENPV, MPENA, PIGTL, WINTR, WSKPV.

**Synonym:** *Tremella conrescens*.

**Notes:** Mycobank 488001. Franciscan Friars and Cedar Lane Park specimens verified by examination of spores by R. Solem. (*S. incrustans* spores are larger.)
