

ID: Buff funnel-shaped cap, stalk color of cap. White mycelium.

Habitat: Single, scattered, groups on leaf litter/duff under hardwoods and conifers.

Cap: 0.4 - 2.4" [1 - 6 cm]

Pale brown (buff/off-white in age). Convex/plane (funnel-shaped in age). Smooth, moist w/ satiny luster (slippery when wet).

Gills: Buff/off-white. Decurrent. Close.

Spores: White. Oval, smooth, hyaline.

Stalk: 0.4 - 2" x 1/16 - 1/4" [1 - 5 cm x 2 - 7 mm]

Buff/off-white. Glabrous. Equal. Hairy white mycelium at base.

Frequency: Occasional.


