**ID:** Parasitic on fungi. Body bluish/gray fuzzy mold covering victims.

**Habitat:** Parasitic on diverse mushroom species; widely distributed in North America.

**Fruiting Body:** Fuzzy mold covering the victim's surfaces; yellow becoming bluish/gray.

**Frequency:** Occasional.

**Locations:** GONRA, LONGC, MCHPV, WSTRP.

**Notes:** Mycobank 211458. Kuo says it has been found on more than 65 different genera in the United States. Four other species have been described. Identification based on macro characteristics, not examination of spores. In photo two, it is growing on a *Russula*.
