

**ID**: Conspicuous zones w/ various contrasting colors; fan-/kidney-/funnel-shaped, often fused. Pores creamy ochre, small.

**Habitat**: Solitary, overlapping clusters or rows. On dead hardwood branches or logs.

**Fruiting Body**: 0.6 - 3.9° [1.5 - 9 cm]

Various contrasting colors (brown/orange/ochre) in conspicuous concentric zones. Velvety/silky/hairy, fibrous. Fan-/kidney-shaped, flattened. Margin thin, wavy. Flesh white; thin layer.

**Pores**: Creamy ochre. Angular/circular (3/mm). Tubes 1-4 mm. Does not stain.

Spores: White. Cylindrical, smooth

**Frequency**: Uncommon.

Locations: WINTR.
