**ID:** Body zones white/pinkish-buff; s-/fan-shaped, overlapping clusters; coarse hairs, margin uneven/wavy in age; stalkless. Pores white (buff in age), labyrinthine/tooth-like in age.

**Habitat:** Overlapping clusters on decaying hardwoods (rarely conifers).

**Fruiting Body:** 1.1 – 3.5" x 0.4" thick [3 – 9 cm x 9 mm]  
White/pinkish-buff/pale cinnamon zones. Coarse hairs. Shell/fan-shaped, leathery to stiff. Margin uneven/wavy in age. Flesh (1 mm) white/pale buff, fibrous-tough.

**Pores:** White (cinnamon-buff in age). Irregular/angular (conspicuously labyrinthine/tooth-like in age).

**Spores:** *White/cream.*

**Frequency:** Occasional.

**Locations:** BIGBR, CASCT, DANPV, PIGTL, RKBPR.

**Notes:** Mycobank 511830.
