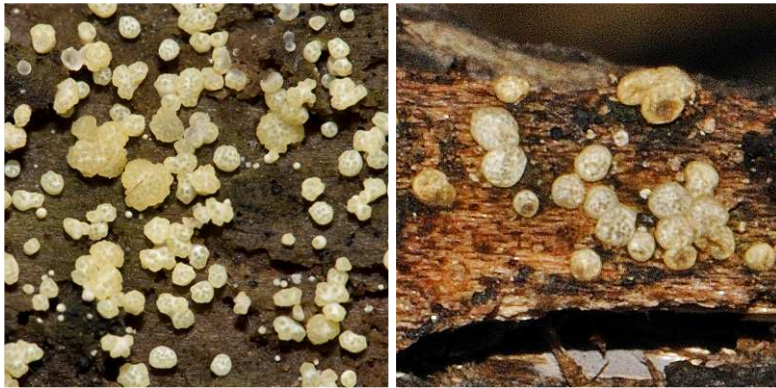

**ID:** White (very young), then pale yellow w/ green dots. Green in age. Soft and gelatinous.

**Habitat:** Dense clusters. Decaying wood.

**Fruiting Body:** 1-32 – 1/8" [1 – 3 mm]

Pale yellow. (White in youth, green dots. Green/dark green in age, perithecia). Cushion-shaped/nearly round. Flesh soft, gelatinous.

**Spores:** Hyaline. Two-part ascospores: one round, one oblong/wedge-shaped; rough, green.

**Frequency:** Occasional.

**Locations:** CEDLP, DANPV, MTPLT, MURHL, WINTR, WSKPV.

**Notes:** Mycobank 536753. Mount Pleasant specimen verified by examination of spores by R. Solem. *H. genatinosa* may be a European species not found here.

**Synonym:** *Hypocrea strictipilosa*.
