## **Decorated Mop**

**ID**: Cap yellowish w/ blackish fibrous scales; convex/flat, central depression. Stalk color/texture like cap.

Habitat: Solitary, small groups. On debarked conifers.

## **Cap**: 1 – 2.2" [2.5 – 6 cm]

Yellowish base color w/ blackish pointed fibrous scales. Convex/nearly flat, sometimes w/ central depression. Margin irregular/wavy. Flesh yellowish, jelly-like.

**Gills**: Yellow. Attached. Crowded. Narrow. Depth = 2X cap flesh. Secondary gills.

Spores: White. Ellipsoid, smooth.


**Stalk**: 1 - 2.2" x 1/8 - 3/8" [2.5 - 6 cm x 3 - 10 mm] Yellow. Tiny, blackish scales. Flesh yellowish. Hollow.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BRNBR, ROBNC, RKBRN, TRIRS, WINFM, WINTR.
