ID: Spindle-shaped clusters of fluted stalks.

Habitat: Scattered, clusters (w/ fused bases). On ground under hardwoods.

Fruiting body: 1.5 – 4” high X 0.4 – 1.1” thick [4 – 10 cm X 1 – 3 cm] Cream/tan (pale brown in age). Cylindric/spindle-shaped; tapers up to roughened tip. Longitudinal wrinkles. Interior chambered.

Spores: Elliptic, coarse warts, hyaline.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: ORRBB.
