Spotted Bolete

ID: Cap reddish-/orange-brown, mottled w/ pale spots (may be nearly unspotted). Pores white (yellow in age), bruise ochre. Stalk whitish, stains pinkish-tan.

Habitat: Scattered, close groups. On ground in mixed forests.

Cap: 1.4 – 4" [3.5 – 10 cm]

Reddish-brown/brown or orange-/yellow-brown, mottled w/ white/pale yellow spots (but may be nearly unspotted). May slowly stain yellow. Smooth/roughened. Convex. Flesh white.

Pores: White/pinkish-white (yellow in age). Depressed near stalk in age. Stain yellow/olive-ochre. Circular (1 - 2/mm). Tubes (8 - 14 mm).

Spores: Yellow-brown/amber. Subfusiform, smooth.

Stalk: 1.1 - 4" x 0.3 - 0.8" [3 - 10 cm x 1 - 2 cm] Whitish; tinged yellowish. Bruising pinkish-tan/brown. Often enlarged base. Flesh pinkish.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: BRNBR, HAMVL, MCHPV, OTHER, RKBRP.

Synonym: Boletus affinis.
