HOWARD BIRD CLUB AUTUMN SEED SALE ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 1982

Seed Sale Coordinator, Eileen Clegg, has announced the first of two seed sales for the 1982-83 year. Prices are listed on the order blank at the bottom of this page. Note that with the exception of niger thistle seed, prices this year are as much as \$1.50 lower than last year's! The 5% Maryland sales tax is included in all prices.

Pickup is at the First Presbyterian Church on Route 108, one-half mile east of Route 29, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, November 6. IF YOU WILL BE UNABLE TO PICK UP YOUR SEED AT THE ANNOUNCED TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT EILEEN IN ADVANCE AT 730-4362. Please note that the club has no storage facilities; therefore, failure to pick up seed without prior notification of the chairwoman will result in forfeiture of your money and seed.

Call Eileen if you would like to volunteer to help during any part of the pickup period either loading seed or working inside at the deak. Those working at the deak receive a small discount on their order; those loading receive a free 20 lb. bag of sunflower seed.

Last January's sale topped 12,000 pounds of seed. Can we beat that? Tell your friends, neighbors, and co-workers. Call Eileen if you would like additional order blanks.

Bookstore Manager, Jan Randle, will have an ample supply of field guides, checklists, records, and related books available on the pickup date at the seed sale desk. Also, some winter bird specimens that might be seen at local feeders will be on display.

Listed below are some of the birds attracted to each of the seed types offered for the November seed sale:

- BLACK OIL SUNFLOWER high oil and calorie content, more popular with most feeder species than striped sunflower seeds. Northern Cardinal, Carolina Chickadee, House and Furple Finches, American Goldfinch, Evening Grosbeak, Blue Jay, Red-breasted and White-breasted Nuthatches, Tufted Titmouse and various species of woodpeckers.
- WHITE PROSO MILLET a small seed containing starch, fat, and protein. Northern Junco, various species of sparrows, Brown-headed Cowbird and other blackbirds, Mourning Dove and Rufous-sided Towhee.
- NIGER THISTLE SEED a tiny seed; a luxury item but it is sometimes the means of attracting Pine Siskins and Common Redpolls as well as the more common finches.
- HULLED SUNFLOWER CHIPS same high food value as whole sunflower but without the mess and waste. Attracts all whole sunflower eaters; smaller finches prefer seeds without hulls.
