MALE: Eyes: green. Face: yellow cross-lined w/ black. Thorax: black w/ 2 lateral yellow stripes. Abdomen: black w/ bright yellow markings. Legs: black. Stigmas: brown. Appendages: black. Flight: carries abdomen curved downward in J shape.

FEMALE: Abdomen: stouter; dorsal stripe wider.

Habitat: Slow-moving rivers; occasionally streams w/ nearby woodlands. May hunt along forest edges.

Reproduction: Female oviposits by swoopping rhythmically to water near bank or fly over open water/tap surface or hover near bank/drop eggs from the air. Larvae hide among submerged leaves; sprawlers. Distinctive exuviae.

Notes: Slow flying; may feed on other dragonflies/large butterflies.
