MALE: Eyes: gray-green. Face: yellow w/ black cross stripes. Thorax: yellowish-green w/ 2 yellow streaks or lateral stripes (2 fusedinto one); sides pale yellowish-green. Abdomen: slender/slightly clubbed; S4-7 black w/ yellow dorsal basal spots or rings. Appendages: whitish w/ distinctive shape.

FEMALE: Paler, spots more extensive.

Habitat: Large sunny areas of rapid rivers and streams; shallow riffles w/ rocks in sun; often forage from tree leaves.

Reproduction: Male makes frequent low fast patrols. Exuviae on side of rocks in stream, tree roots 1' up.

Notes: Was Lanthus albistylus.
