
## **Directions to Brighton Dam**

## **Directions to Brighton Dam**

To reach the intersection of Brighton Dam Road and Highland Road there are two options. From US 29 go west on MD 216/Highland Road 6.0 miles to a left turn on Brighton Dam Road OR take MD 32 to Clarksville, go west on Ten Oaks Road 0.6 mile to the junction with Brighton Dam Road (as Ten Oaks Road makes a wide right-hand curve, Brighton Dam Road goes straight); continue 1.5 miles to the intersection with Highland Road. Continue straight on Brighton Dam Road 1.7 miles to the dam (the road runs along the top of it). Cross the dam and park in the lot on the left in Montgomery County. Boat permits may be purchased at the log office adjacent to the parking lot; everyone needs a pass, which can be obtained at the log office. Brighton Dam straddles the Howard/Montgomery county line, forming the lower end of Triadelphia Reservoir. The dam and land surrounding the reservoir are owned by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC). At the cabin in the parking lot, you may pick up a map (which shows access points to both reservoirs in both counties) and your pass (daily or yearly). The reservoir is open from March 15 to December 15 (both dates are contingent on open water). On all WSSC property, dogs must be leashed and no swimming or wading is permitted.
