- Eastern Wood-Pewee: 1
- *Empidonax* species: 2 - silent
- Eastern Phoebe: 1
- Blue Jay: Several
- American Crow: 1 (heard - distant)
- Carolina Chickadee: >1
- Tufted Titmouse: 1
- Carolina Wren: Several
- House Wren: 1
- Blue-gray Gnatcatcher: 1
- Eastern Bluebird: several at entrance
- Gray Catbird: Several
- Northern Mockingbird: 2
- European Starling: small group
- American Redstart: 1 - full male
- Eastern Towhee: Several, including two recently fledged
- Field Sparrow: few
- Northern Cardinal: Several
- Indigo Bunting: groups calling in undergrowth
- American Goldfinch: numerous and vocal
