Plants: Anise Root, Black Cohosh (leaves), Bulbous Buttercup, Chickweed, Cleavers, Common Blue Violet, Common Dandelion, Garlic mustard, Gill-over-the-ground, Hobblebush, Indian Strawberry, Kidneyleaf Buttercup, Mayapple, One-flowered Cancerroot, Perfoliate Bellwort, Purple Dead Nettle, Snakeroot (one of the *Sanicula* sp.), Spring Beauty, Star Chickweed, Wild Cucumber (leaves), Wild Geranium, Wild Ginger, Wild Yamroot (leaves), Yellow Avens, Yellow Wood Sorrel.
