How to Find an Owl 2020 Report Jay Sheppard

February 22, 2020, was a beautiful day, maybe a little crisp in the early AM. Bright and sunny! The first session started at 9:30 with 19 participants and three instructor assistants; the afternoon class started at 1:00 PM with 19 new participants and three instructor assistants Names of all are listed below.

Each session started off with a discussion of habitat and prey needs of our owls. How we need to focus on the prey's habitat first and then see if there are any owls benefitting from the abundance of the local prey. We examined a variety of owl pellets and their contents. After this informational part of the class, the participants filed over to the white pines nearby. They all lined up and took a row of pines. Then they slowly walked down the rows looking for scat/droppings and pellets of owls and other wildlife. They found some Northern Saw-whet Owl pellets in about eight sites in these pines. Those are the first signs of this owl from this extensive pine plantation for this whole winter. The freshest pellet was maybe 4–5 days old. That was about as close as we got to finding any special owls–saw-whets, Long-eared, etc.

All participants got a 'Certificate' for completing this little class and hopefully they will all now find owls in their bird walks around Maryland and elsewhere. It was disappointing not finding any saw-whets or other owls, but everyone seemed to appreciate the time spent learning to look down for signs of owls and not just up.
