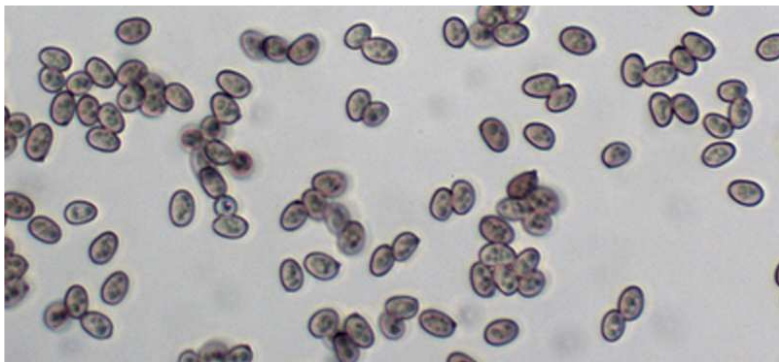

ID: Cap whitish; smooth/minutely fibrillose; convex (broadly convex in age). Stalk white; fragile white ring.

Habitat: Scattered or groups/clusters/fairy rings. Grassy areas.

Cap: 1.6 – 4” [4 – 10 cm]
Whitish. Smooth/minutely radially fibrillose. Not bruising.

Gills: Pinky brown (dark brown in age).

Spores: *Dark brown*. Ellipsoid, smooth, light brown.

Stalk: 1.2 – 2.4” [3 – 6 cm]
White. Smooth. Equal w/ tapered base.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HAMVL.

Notes: Mycobank 308336. Western Regional Park specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem and info provided by R. Patrick (iNaturalist).

Synonyms: *A. campestris*. *Psalliota campestris*.
