





OVERALL: Western Regional Park, 8/11/2019, *J. Solem.* SPORES (6.5-7.5 x 4.2-5.0 µ): Western Regional Park, 8/11/2019, *R. Solem.* GILLS, STALK: Western Regional Park, 8/11/2019, *J. Solem.*

ID: Cap whitish; smooth/minutely fibrillose; convex (broadly convex in age). Stalk white; fragile white ring.

Habitat: Scattered or groups/clusters/fairy rings. Grassy areas.

Cap: 1.6 - 4" [4 - 10 cm]

Whitish. Smooth/minutely radially fibrillose. Not bruising.

Gills: Pinky brown (dark brown in age).

Spores: Dark brown. Ellipsoid, smooth, light brown.

Stalk: 1.2 - 2.4" [3 - 6 cm]

White. Smooth. Equal w/ tapered base.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HAMVL.
