

ID: Cap whitish; smooth; convex (broadly convex in age). Stalk white; fragile white ring.

Habitat: Scattered or groups/clusters/fairy rings. Grassy areas.

Cap: 1.2 - 2.8" [3 - 7 cm]

Whitish/buff. Convex (broadly convex in age). Dry. Smooth. Not bruising.

Gills: Pink (brownish, then dark brown in age). Free.

Spores: Dark brown/black. Ovate.

Stalk: 1.2 - 2.4" [3 - 6 cm]

White. Smooth. Equal, tapered base; fragile white ring.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: HAMVL.
