ID: Wavy orange cup (often clustered).

Habitat: Solitary/groups/clusters. Grass, disturbed soil, along roadsides.

Fruiting body: 3/8 – 4" [1 – 10 cm]

Fertile surface: Yellow-/bright-orange, smooth.

Outer surface: Yellow/pale yellowish-orange, slightly scurfy.

Margin: Wavy, often torn in age.

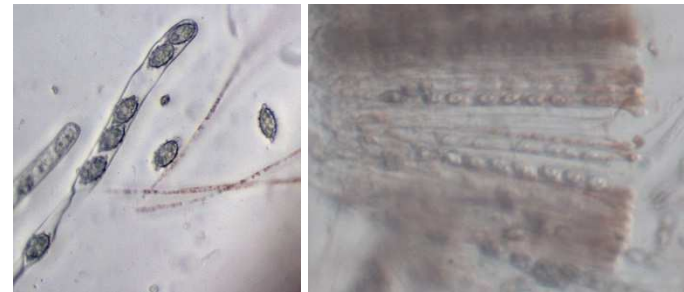
Frequency: Occasional.

Spores: Hyaline, 2 oil drops, prominent spike on each end.

Locations: DANPV, HENPV, OTHER.

Notes: Mycobank 473871. Henryton specimen verified by examination of spores by R. Solem; however, the size corresponds to an unnamed Western variety (*vide* Kuo and Arora, p.837).
