ID: Cap dark yellow-brown, viscid when wet; convex (flatter in age). Pores yellow. Stalk yellow at top, reddish-brown below; white mycelium at base. Flesh, pores, stalk instantly stain deep blue then gray/brown.

Habitat: Solitary, groups. On ground in forests.

Cap: 1.5 - 3" [4 - 7.5 cm]

Dark yellow-brown/dark-/reddish-brown. Viscid when wet. Velvety/powdery (smooth/irregular and slightly shiny in age). Convex (nearly flat in age). Thick yellow flesh, instantly stains deep blue.

Pores: Yellow/golden-yellow. Instantly stains deep blue, later tan/brown. Irregular (1 - 2/mm). Tubes (6 - 12 mm).

Spores: Olive-brown. Fusoid/elliptical, smooth.

Stalk: 1.8 - 3.6" x 0.4 - 1" [4 - 8 cm x 1 - 2.5 cm]

Yellow at top, reddish-orange/reddish-brown below. Faint striations. Cylindrical. Flesh instantly bruises blue/black, then gray/brown. White mycelium at base.

Frequency: Occasional.

Locations: ROBNC, ROGOR, TRIRS.

Synonym: Boletus pulverulentus.
