



ID: Cap orange-brown, margin paler (fades in age); broadly convex (funnel-shaped in age). Latex white, dries brown. Foul odor in age. Use FeSO₄.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in hardwood/ mixed forests.

Cap: 2 - 4" [5 - 10 cm]

Orange-/cinnamon-brown disc, paler toward margin (fades in age). Wide, broadly convex (broadly funnel-shaped in age). Margin inrolled w/ veil remnants: ages brownish. Flesh (6 mm) pale vellow: bruises brown. Latex white, dries dark brown/black. Develops foul (fishy) odor in age.

Gills: Whitish-cream; bruise tawny-brown. Broad. Decurrent, often forked. Depth 6 – 10 mm.

Spores: White. Round/nearly round, ornamented w/ warts & ridges; reticulated; 1 µm prominences.

Stalk: 2 – 4.5" [5 – 11.5 cm]

Pale orange-brown/dull orange. Nearly smooth. Equal/tapers to base. Stuffed (sometimes hollow in age).

Frequency: Common.

Locations: BIGBR, CASCT, FRANF, GONRA, HIRIP, NOLAP, PIGTL, ROGOR, SAVPK, UMDCF, WDLPV, WINTR, WSTRP.

Notes: Mycobank 231293. Gorman Stream Valley NRA record identified by examination of spores by R. Solem. FeSO₄ instantly turns flesh dark blueareen.
