

Orbiliaceae Orbiliales



ID: Various colors when fresh; paler in age.

Habitat: Scattered, groups, clusters. On decaying hardwood.

Fruiting Body: 1/32 - 1/8" [1 – 3 mm] diameter

Various colors when fresh, paler in age. Shallow translucent cup centrally attached. Fertile surface smooth; infertile surface slightly scurfy.

Stalk: None.

Frequency: Fairly common.

Locations: FARMS, HENPV, HIRIP, MURHL, SLMLP, WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 81091. The family *Orbiliaceae* is composed of 12 genera. Two with macro characteristics likely to attract amateurs are *Hyalorbilia* and *Orbilia*. All require microscopic examination of multiple characteristics to determine precise identification.
