ID: Cap dingy yellowish-brown, Fruiting body extremely fragile.

Habitat: Scattered, groups. Near decaying hardwood stumps or debris (including buried wood); on woodchips or lawns.

Cap: 0.4 – 1.6" [1 – 4 cm]

Dingy yellowish-brown (pale buff-brown in age). Moist, hygrophanous. Conic/convex (nearly flat in age). Conic/bell-shaped w/ umbo in age. Margin striate at first. Thin flesh colored like cap.

Gills: Dingy buff (brownish-gray in age). Notched. Close/crowded.

Spores: Purplish-brown. Ellipsoid, smooth, brown w/ apical pore.

Stalk: 1.6 – 3.2 x 1/16 – 1/8" [4 – 8 cm x 1.5 – 3.0 mm]
Color of cap. Equal (sometimes twisted).

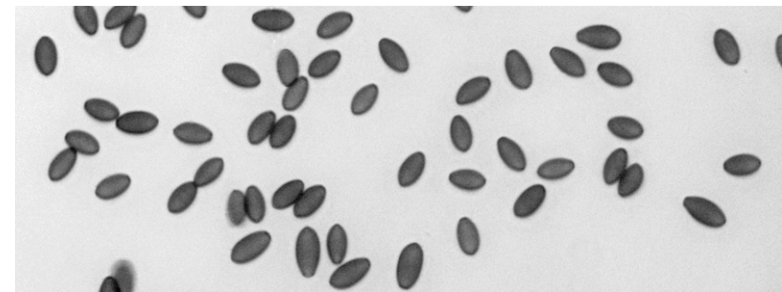
Frequency: Infrequent.

Locations: HAMVL.
